csvcount – print the number of fields and rows in a CSV file

**SYNOPSIS**

**csvcount** [**OPTION**]... [**FILE**]...

**DESCRIPTION**

Read CSV data from standard input or one or more specified files and print the number of fields and rows encountered.

**-d, --delimiter=DELIM**

Use *DELIM* instead of the comma character as the delimiter character

**-q, --quote=QUOTE**

Use *QUOTE* instead of double quote as the quote character

**-f, --fields**

Print only the number of fields in each file

**-r, --rows**

Print only the number of rows in each file

**--help** Display a help message and exit

**--version**

Print version information to stderr and exit
